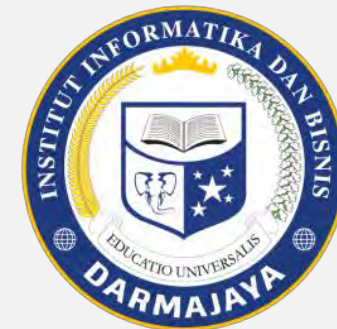




# Project Management Concepts

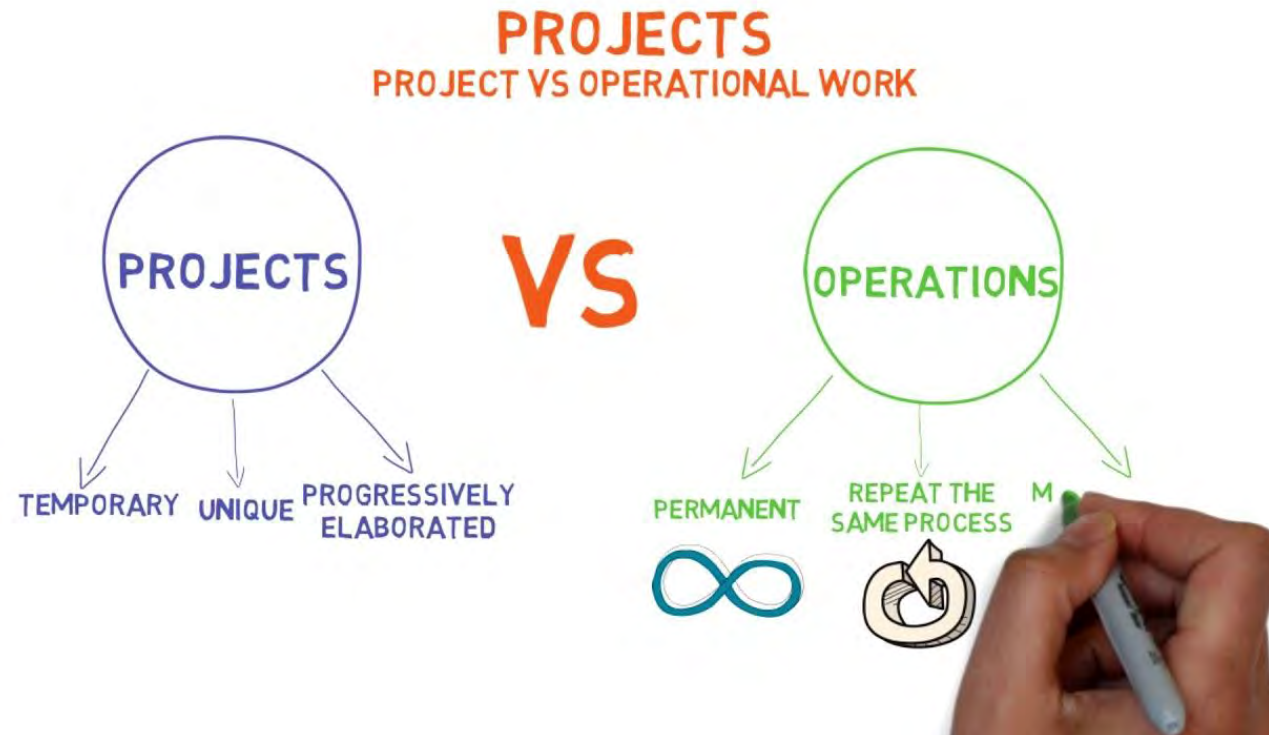
# Projects vs. Ongoing Operations

- **Techniques**

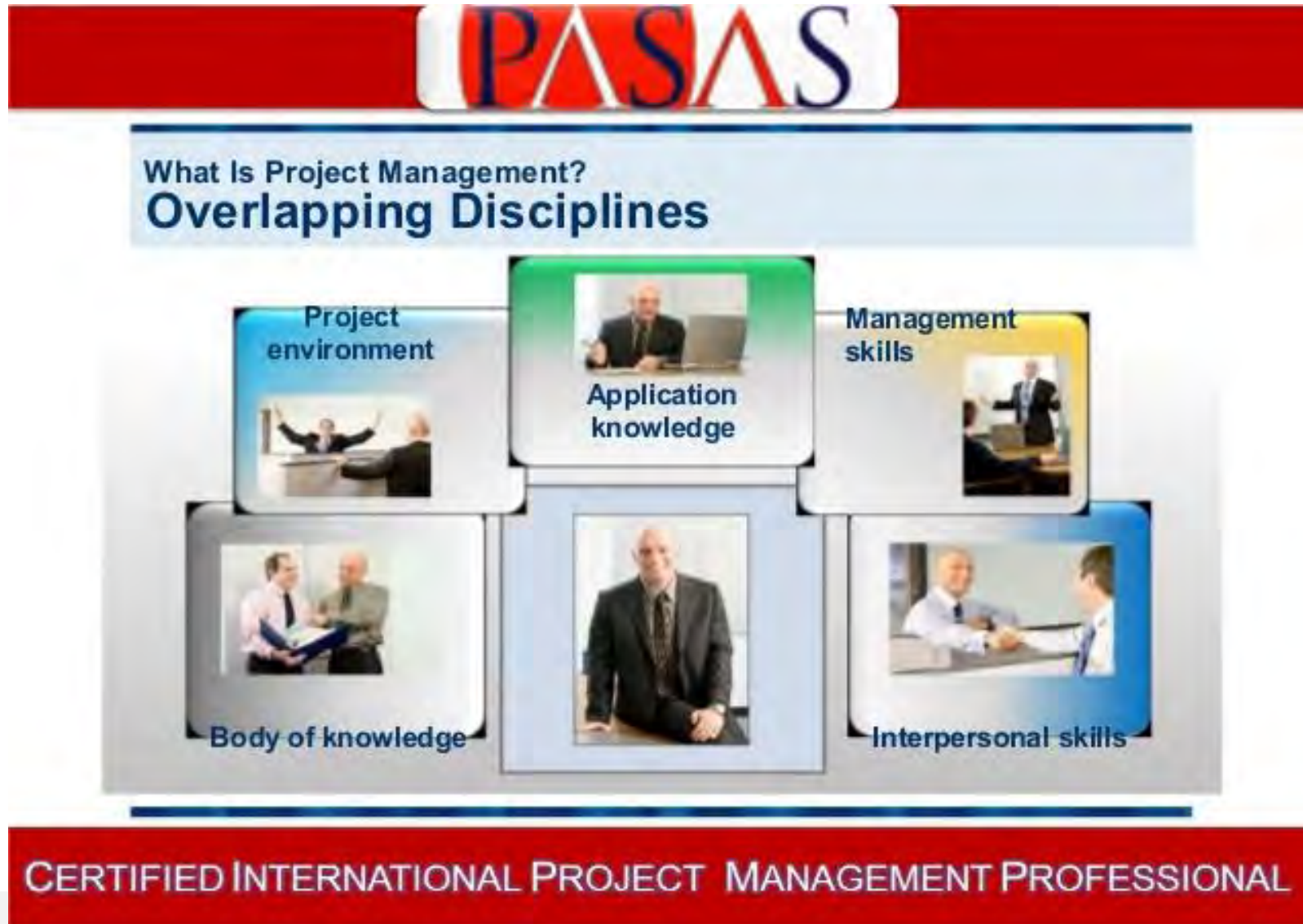
**It is accomplished through 5 (five) process groups :**

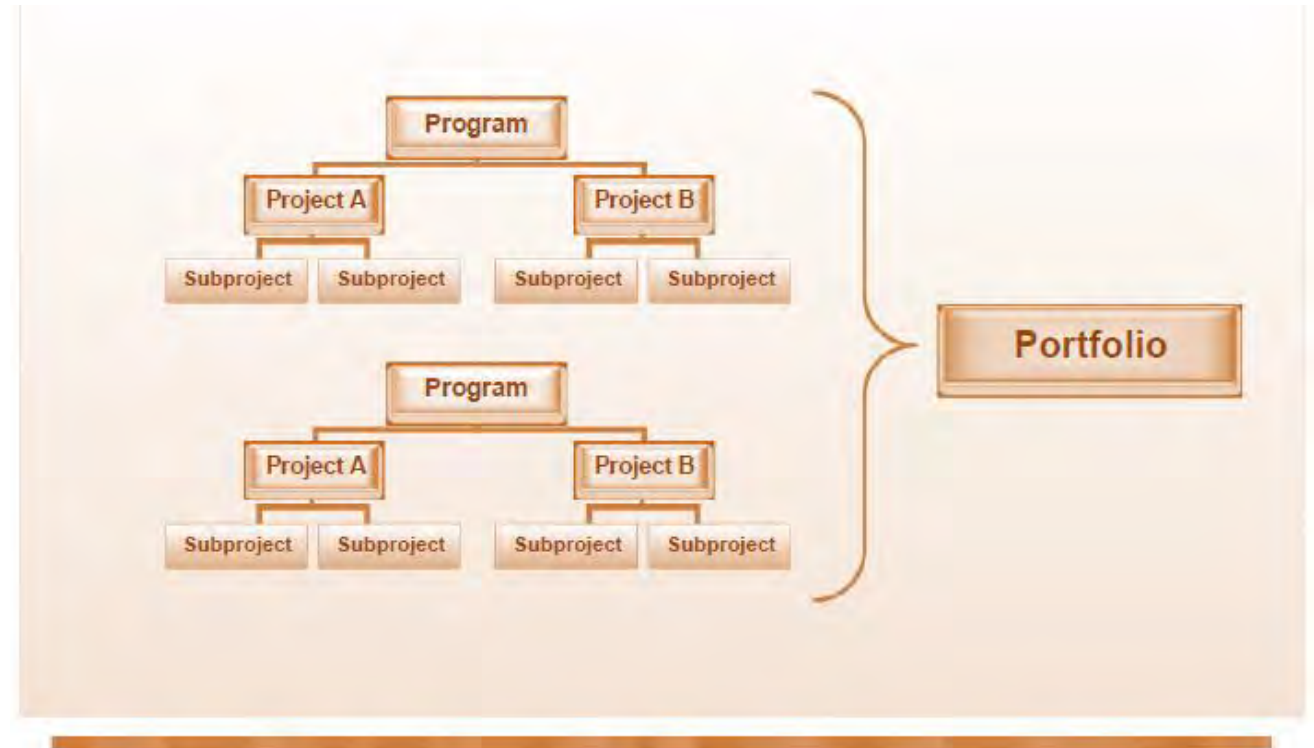


# Project Management Components

- Portfolios
- Programs

A **project** is focused on creating a unique product, service, or result. A **program** is a collection of **projects** that need to be managed and coordinated together. And, a **portfolio** is a collection of **projects** and programs that are managed as a group to achieve strategic goals and a business value



# Project Management Components

- **Project management office**

A *Project Management Office* (PMO) is a group or *department* within a business, government agency, or enterprise that defines and maintains standards for *project management* within the organization.



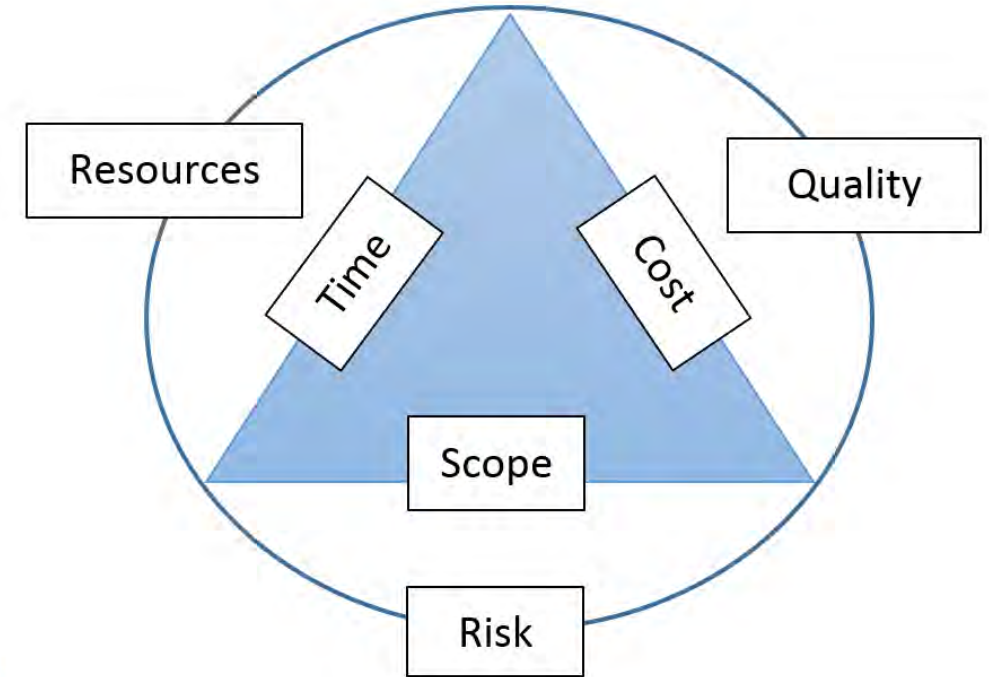
# Project Management System

- A **project management system** is a means of **managing** a **project** by planning, organizing, and **managing** its different required aspects.
- Depending on the sophistication of the **project management system**, it can include: Estimation activities. Scheduling. Cost control and budget **management**
