

PHRASAL VERB

DEFINITION

Is a combination between word Verb and a preposition or verb + adverb which have same meaning or have different meaning from the real meaning as well

Example (verb + preposition)= crash on
verb preposition

Example (verb+ adverb)= go away
verb Adverb

TYPES OF PHRASAL VERB

I. Literate usage

Means have the same meaning with the real meaning of its word.

The examples of phrasal verb which are literate usage ; look at, go away, walk across, run into, hurry up, growing up, etc

He looks at me deeply (menatap)

I walk across the street (berjalan menyebrangi)

II. Idiomatic Usage

It means that phrasal verb merubah arti dari kata kerja aslinya. So itu berarti kombinasi kata tersebut memiliki arti yang berbeda dengan kata kerja yang sesungguhnya.

The examples of phrasal verb which are idiomatic usage ;
take after (mirip sperti), put off (melepaskan)
run out (habis), carry out (mengerjakan), look after (merawat), look for (mencari), wait on (melayani), count on (mengandalkan) etc

example of the sentence

Please put off your shoes and come to the class

She looks after her father in the hospital

For your more information there is no specific rules which explain how can these phrasal verb formed, there is no special formula also. It has been directly included into dictionary.

So make sure that you always open up your dictionary and practice it by your self
