

Coordinating Conjunction

conjunction coordinates are words that connect phrases, clauses, and other words. In other words, a coordinate conjunction is a form of conjunction that functions to connect an equivalent sentence.

Conjunctions (Kata Sambung)

If the **subject of a single sentence is different**, then the sentence **combination** does **not** change in the compound sentence.

Example :

- A. He wanted to see me.
I was not at home.
(He wanted to see me, but I was not home)
- B. I agreed to go with you.
My parents forbade me.
(I agreed to go with you, but my parents forbade me)

If the **subject of a single sentence is same**, then **subject on the second sentence that the same is eliminated** in the compound sentence.

Example :

- A. They didn't go to school.
They played truant.
(They didn't go to school but played truant)
- B. Albert said "Good night".
He went to bed.
(Albert said "Good night" **and** went to bed)

Other Conjunctions :

- Because – sebab / karena
- When – ketika / apabila
- Before – sebelum
- After – sesudah
- Until – sampai
- Although – meskipun
