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Conjunctions is a word which connects two words or clauses or sentence / phrases and shows the relation between them .

Type of Conjunctions

- Coordinating Conjunctions : For, And, Nor, But, Or, Yet, Soon.
- Subordinating Conjunctions : Although, As, Before, Once, Though, Until, Whether, Etc.
- Correlative Conjunctions : Both / And, Either / Or, Just as / so, Neither / Nor, Not Only / but Also, Etc.

Funboys Comparison

For : Because : Sam drunk some water, for he was thirsty.

And : In addition to : I take milk and sugar in my tea.

Nor : And not : Sara doesn't like apples, nor does she like pears

But : However : All the children wanted to eat pizza, but no one wanted to buy it.

Or : Either : We could go to a zoo, or we could go to a theme park.

Yet : But : The weather was cold and wet. yet we enjoyed very much.

So : Therefore : He is sick. so he is not going to the school.

Subordinate Conjunction.

- Time-related conjunctions : after, as soon as, as long as, before, once, still, until, when, whenever, while.
- Concession and Comparison : although, as though, even though, just as, though, whereas.
- Cause Conjunctions : as, because, in order that, since, so that.
- Condition Conjunctions : even if, if, in case, provided that.
- Place Conjunctions : where, wherever, whereas.
