- Expands impact



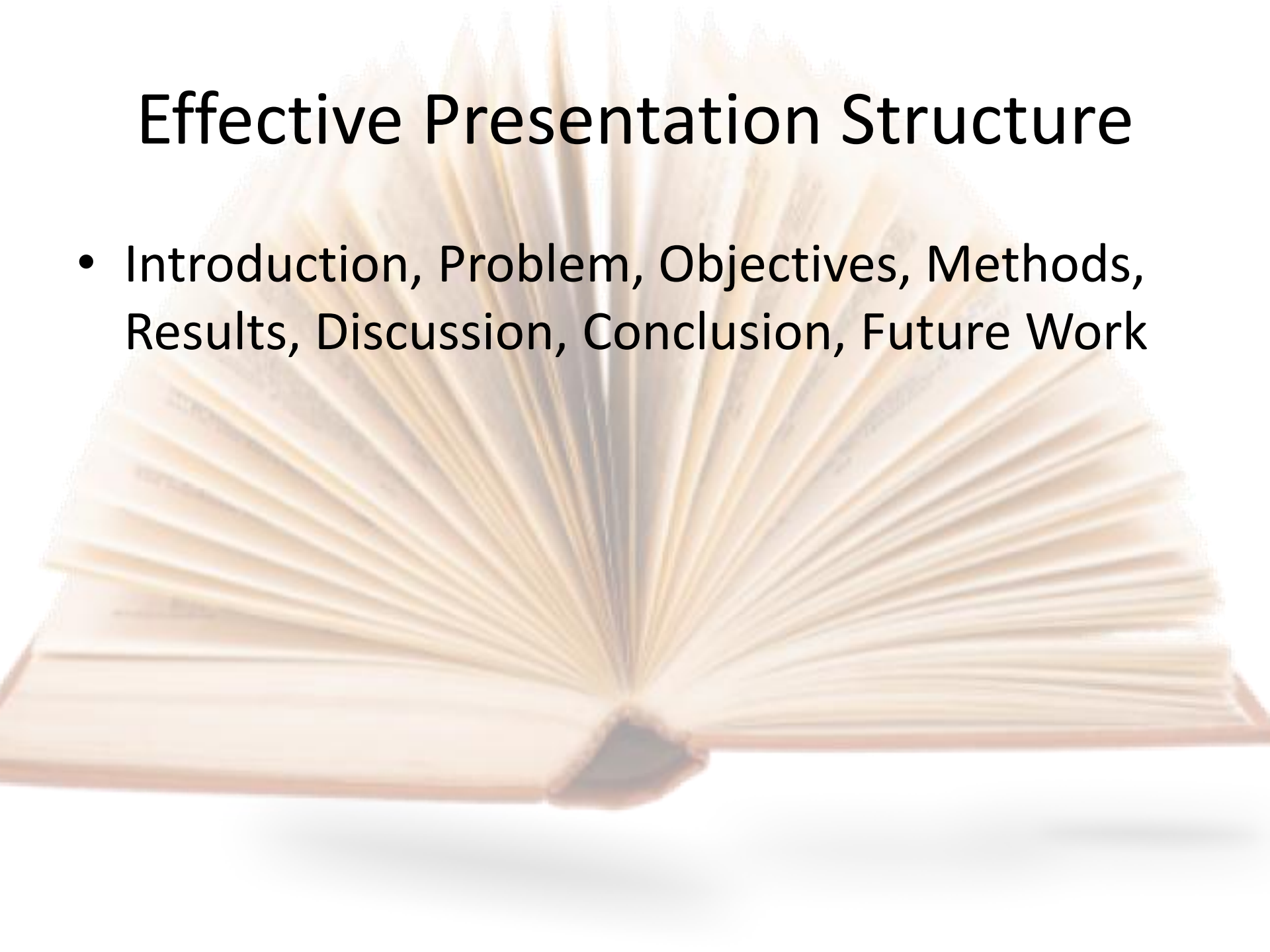
Preparing Your Research Findings

Effective Presentation Structure

- Introduction, Problem, Objectives, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Future Work

- • Q&A prep

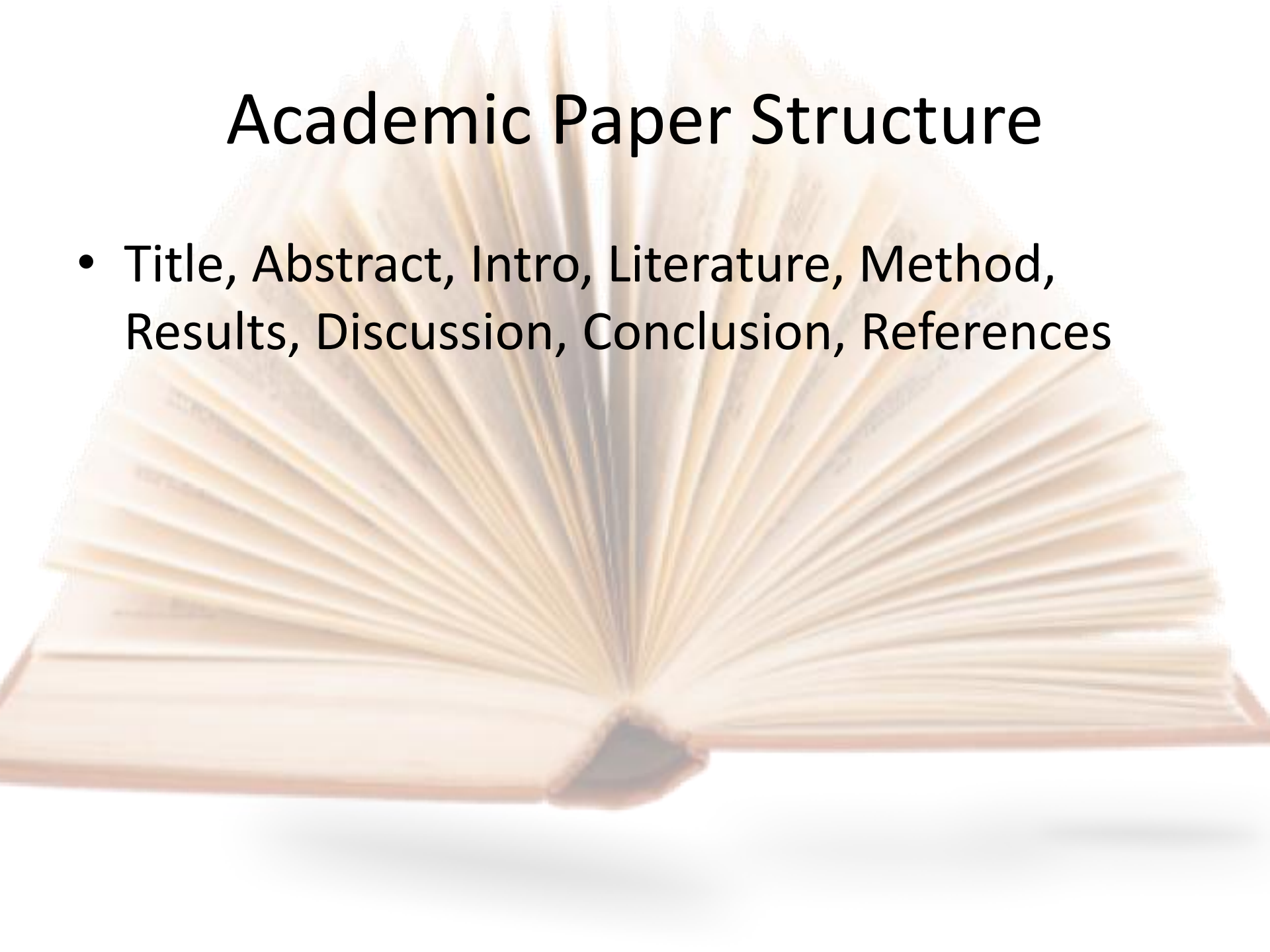
Choosing the Right Journal

- Title, Abstract, Intro, Literature, Method, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, References



Writing Tips



- Concise
- Cite properly
- Follow journal format
- Ensure originality
- High-quality figures
